SECTION 2: Hazardous properties

- **2.1 Classification of the mixture:**The product does not meet the criteria for classification as hazardous according to Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 (CLP).

SECTION 3: Composition/information on ingredients

The product is a water-based solution.

SECTION 4: First aid measures

- **4.1 Description of first aid measures:**
 - **If inhaled:** Move the person to fresh air if discomfort occurs when spraying.
 - **In case of skin contact:** Rinse skin with water.
 - **In case of eye contact:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
 - **If swallowed:** Rinse mouth with clean water. Drink a few glasses of water. Seek medical attention if discomfort occurs.

SECTION 5: Firefighting measures

- **5.1 Extinguishing media:** The product is water-based and non-flammable. Adapt extinguishing media to surrounding fire (water curtain, foam, powder, carbon dioxide).
- **5.2 Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture:** No specific fire hazards. Decomposition may occur on extreme heating.

SECTION 6: Accidental release measures

- **6.1 Personal protective measures:** Avoid breathing spray mist during decontamination.
- **6.2 Environmental protection measures:** Prevent large spills from reaching sewer systems or waterways.
- **6.3 Methods for containment and cleaning up:** Wipe up with absorbent material (e.g. cloth, sand or universal absorbent). Rinse thoroughly with water.

SECTION 7: Handling and storage

- **7.1 Precautions for safe handling:** Use as directed. Avoid spraying directly into the eyes or inhaling the spray mist for extended periods of time.
- **7.2 Conditions for safe storage:** Store in original packaging in a cool, well-ventilated place. Protect from frost. Keep out of the reach of children.

SECTION 8: Exposure controls/personal protection

- **8.1 Control parameters:** No national occupational exposure limits have been established for this diluted mixture.
- **8.2 Exposure controls:**
 - **Eye protection:** Normally not necessary for intended use. If there is a risk of splashing (e.g. during industrial bottling), wear tight-fitting safety glasses.
 - **Skin/Hand protection:** Not required for normal consumer use. For prolonged professional handling, nitrile gloves are recommended.
 - **Respiratory protection:** Ensure good ventilation. Avoid intentional inhalation of spray mist.

SECTION 9: Physical and chemical properties

- **Shape/Appearance:** Liquid (sprayable solution)
- **Paint:** Clear, colorless
- **Works:** Odorless (or perfumed if fragrance has been added)
- **pH value:** Slightly acidic to neutral (approx. 5.0–7.0)
- **Boiling point:** about 100 °C

SECTION 10: Stability and reactivity

- **10.1 Reactivity:** Stable under normal handling and storage conditions.
- **10.2 Chemical stability:** Stable under normal temperature conditions.
- **10.3 Incompatible materials:** Strong bases and strong reducing agents.

SECTION 11: Toxicological information

- **11.1 Information on hazard classes:**
 - **Acute toxicity:** The product does not meet the criteria for classification.
 - **Skin irritation/irritation:** Not classified.
 - **Serious eye damage/eye irritation:** May cause mild, mechanical or temporary irritation if splashed directly into the eye.
 - **Reproductive toxicity:** Boric acid is classified as Repr. 1B. Since the content in FootLife is below the limit value of 0.3%, the product is classified **notas** reproductive toxicant.

SECTION 12: Ecological information

- **12.1 Toxicity:** The product is not classified as environmentally hazardous. Long-term harmful effects in the aquatic environment are not expected.

SECTION 13: Disposal considerations

- **13.1 Waste treatment methods:** Empty and well-rinsed plastic bottles can be sent for plastic recycling. Larger residual quantities of the product are handled as chemical waste according to local municipal regulations.
- **Proposed EWC waste code:** 07 06 99 (Other wastes from the manufacture, formulation, distribution and use of fats, lubricants, soaps and detergents).

SECTION 14: Transport information

The product is not covered by transport regulations (ADR/RID/IMDG/IATA) as it is not classified as dangerous goods.

SECTION 15: Regulatory information

- **15.1 REACH & CLP:** Prepared in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH) and (EC) No 1272/2008 (CLP) of the European Parliament and of the Council.
- **Contains substance on the candidate list (SVHC):** Yes, boric acid (CAS 10043-35-3) in a concentration of < 0.3%.
